



My Experience with ADIN dental implants

ADIN clinical case competition - Guidelines

ADIN Dental implant Systems LTD will hold its International Symposium in Costa Rica, in March 2018. As part of the conference, selected cases under the title "**My Experience with ADIN dental implants**" will be presented. The cases will be presented as posters in a designated area for the duration of the conference, and at specific time that will be allocated in the formal schedule.

All practicing dentists are entitled to submit cases to the competition.

Evaluation process

Members of ADIN's scientific advisory board and the lecturers will evaluate the cases during the Symposium, and will grant prizes to the three best presented cases. Each one of the other contributors of cases that will meet specified terms for participation will receive a package of 2 ADIN implants of their choice.

Criteria of evaluation will include: adhering to the terms of participation, level of complexity, a comparison of the pre and post treatment conditions, level of documentation, and overall treatment success.

Terms of participation

1. Cases should be written in English.
2. Cases that involve the use of dental implants as part of the treatment plan.
3. Use of ADIN dental implants.
4. Complete case description including the following:
 - a. Consent and release forms signed by the patient, accepting the treatment by dental implants and approving the use of their documentation for publication and educational use.
 - b. A full set of radiographs and photographs, of the pre-treatment condition.
 - c. A short paragraph describing alternative treatment options and why the specific treatment option was chosen.
 - d. In-process photographs and radiographs (when of significance), illustrating all clinical steps.
 - e. Photographs of interim/temporary restorations.
 - f. Post-operative radiographs and photographs.
 - g. A short final discussion including a timeline of the treatment process, description of difficulties (if occurred) and any other data relevant to the presented case.
 - h. An acknowledgement/s to the Dental technicians and any other clinicians that were involved in the presented case.

5. Patients and all clinicians involved in submitted cases must sign the following statements:

Patients:

I, the undersigned, confirm that I received sufficient explanation from my doctor, including regarding the confidentiality of my identifying details. Subject to the above, I hereby allow Dr. _____ to use all data of the case I was involved in, including photographs, radiographs, images and written description, for case presentation to be submitted to Adin Dental Implant Systems Ltd. and used for ADIN's educational and marketing purposes.

Doctors:

I, the undersigned, hereby declare as follows:

- a) I explained to the patient involved in the case about the publication of the case and received his/hers consent.
- b) I allow ADIN Dental Implant Systems Ltd. to use all the data I submitted to them as part of the case I chose to present, including photographs, radiographs, images and written description, for ADIN's educational and marketing purposes.

Guidelines for photography

The publication: "A guide to Accreditation Photography" by the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry is recommended as a good resource that illustrate image types and quality.

Photographs and images should be submitted in the highest possible resolution, preferably in RAW format.

Submission of cases

Final registration date for participation in the posters presentation is January 31st, 2018.

All cases must be submitted to ADIN by email to: hadass@adin-implants.com, no later than February 28th, 2018.

Participants should print the cases in size 0.9x1.2 m and bring them to the Symposium.

Example of the desired clinical case format is attached.

Important note

The evaluation process and prizes award for the 3 first winners shall be held **only** if a minimum of 30 cases in total are submitted by February 28th, 2018.
